## MEETING #6

## OLD BUSINESS

1. Student Directory Committee - no report.
2. Mr. Duink's proposal of policy - 2nd Reading: Vote: (8-1) passed (for the text, see Minutes of November 12, 1974).
3. RAC Drug Statement - 2nd Reading: Vote: (6-4) passed (for text see Faculty Senate pages 88-90).
4. Undergraduate Bulletin - still not in yet; tentative date set for first week in December.

## NEW BUSINESS

1. Discussion of freshmen mid-semester grades: Dr. Young stated that as far as he knows, freshmen mid-semester grades are not being sent to parents and are for informational purposes only.
2. Discussion of structure for dealing with health services: In case of refund due to illness, a student should contact the Dean of Students. The Committee was informed that the Infirmary is not a facility for the college community, just students. Dr. Young commented that approximately \$35-40 is spent per head count per year. A question was raised of the possibility of forming a committee on health services employing members of the Student Affairs Committee. No decision was made pending a discussion with Dr. Burgess.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:15 p.m.
