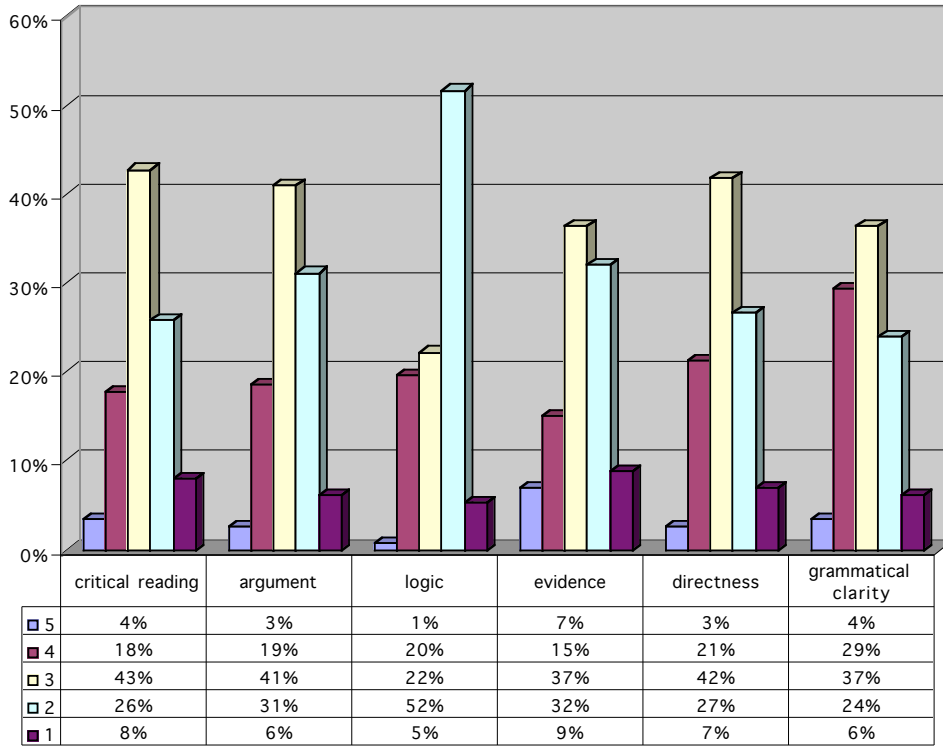

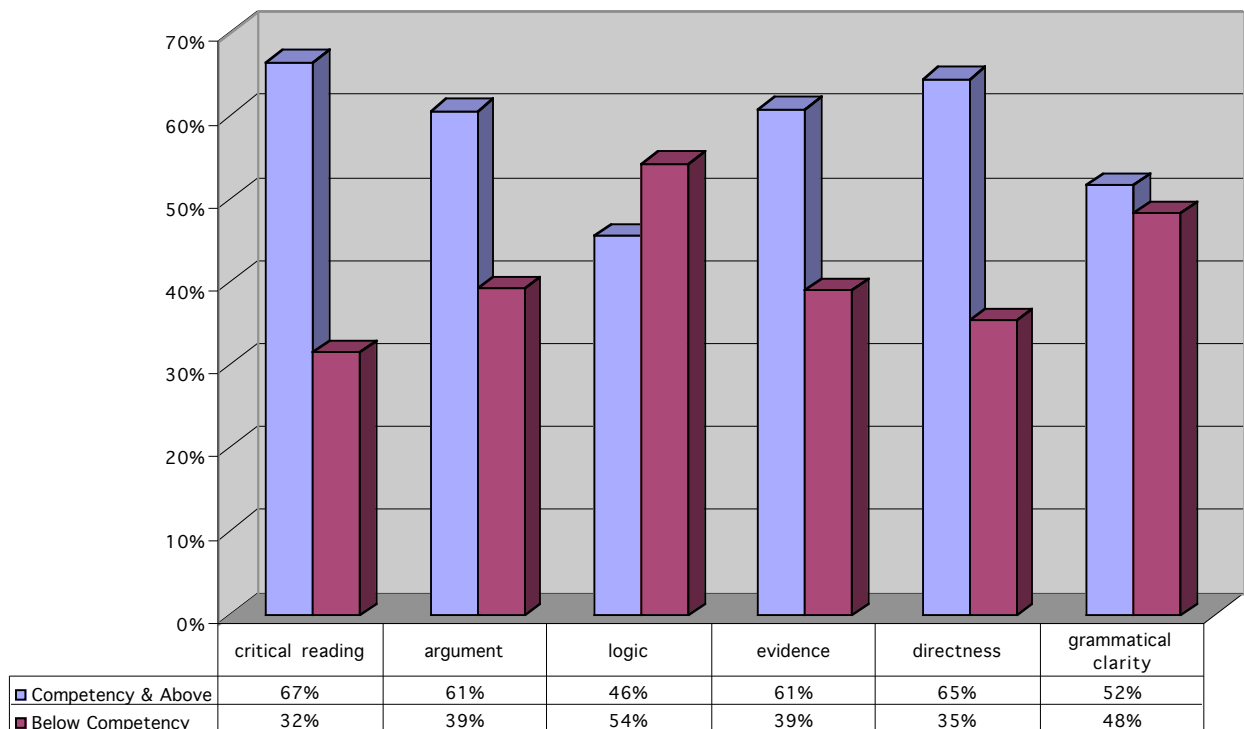

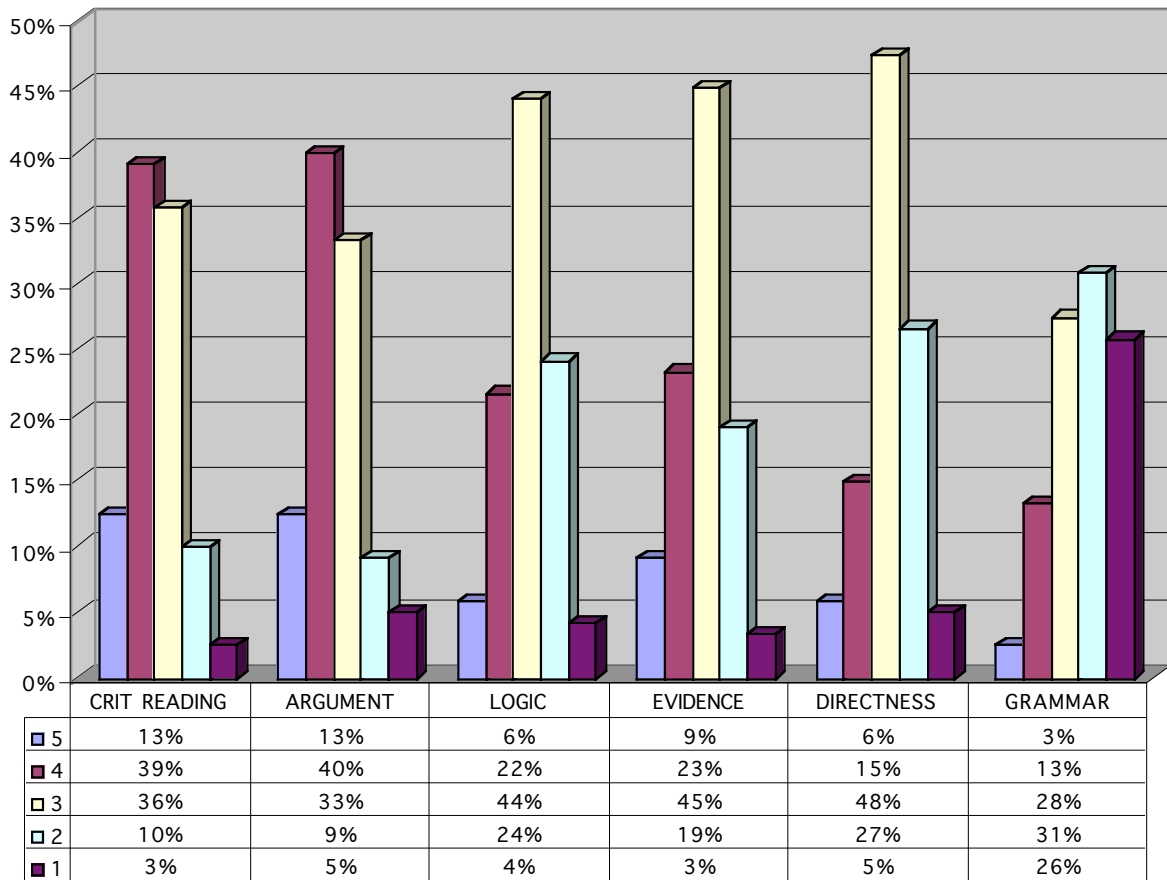


INTD 105 Competency Totals

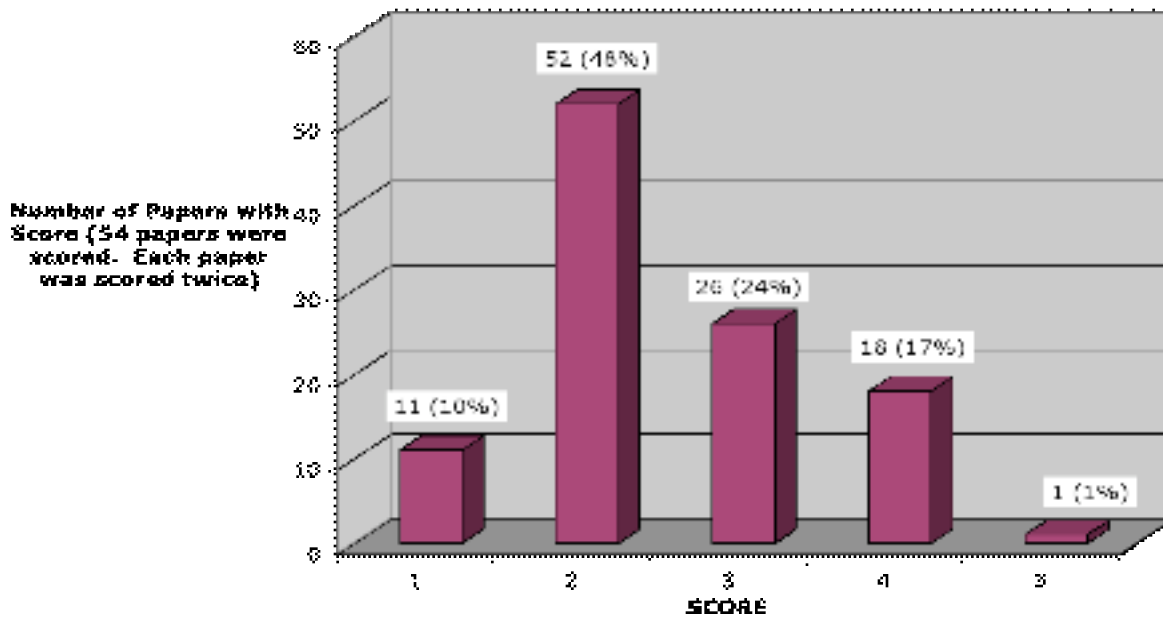
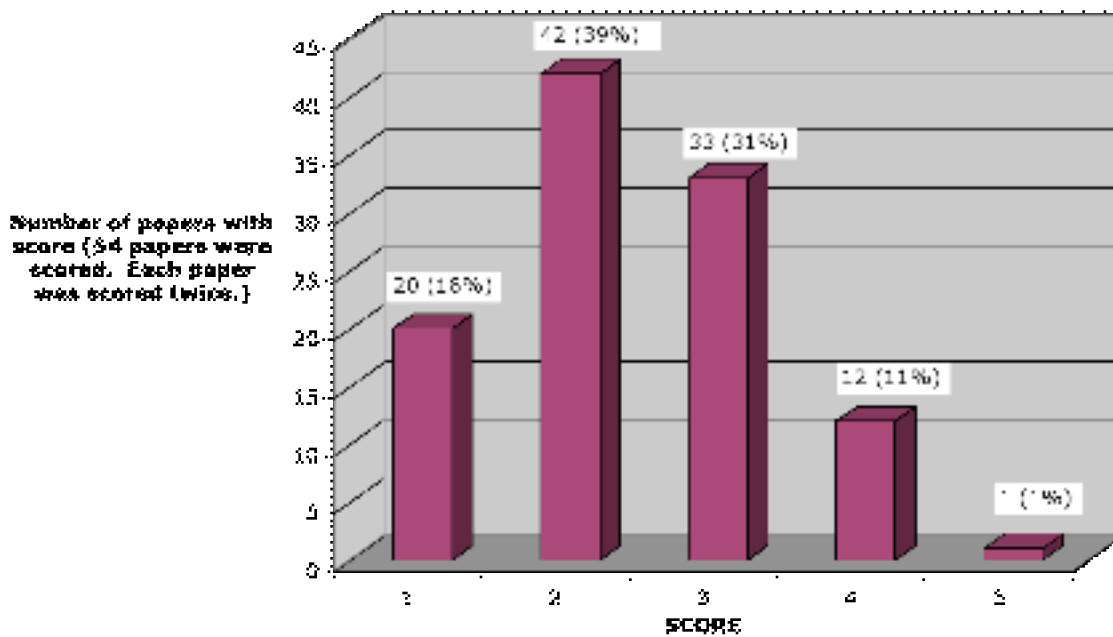
